**CHANGE OF ACTIVE TO PASSIVE**

SITA PREPARES DISHES .....(1)  
THE SUBJECT (SITA) DOES SOMETHING.  
THE WORD 'PREPARES' IS SAID TO BE IN ACTIVE VOICE.

DISHES ARE PREPARED BY SITA .....(2)  
THE VERB 'ARE PREPARED' SHOWS THAT SOMETHING IS DONE TO THE SUBJECT I.E. THE SUBJECT IS ACTED UPON.  
THE WORD 'ARE PREPARED' IS SAID TO BE IN PASSIVE VOICE.

**DEFINITION -**  
A VERB IS SAID TO BE IN ACTIVE VOICE WHEN ITS SUBJECT ACTS. A VERB IS SAID TO BE IN PASSIVE VOICE WHEN ITS SUBJECT IS ACTED UPON.

**RULES TO REMEMBER**

1. IN THE ACTIVE VOICE, AN ACTIVE VOICE VERB REMAINS THE SUBJECT AS IT IS IN THE PASSIVE VOICE.
2. ALWAYS USE THE THIRD PERSON OF A VERB IN THE PASSIVE VOICE.
3. IF THE SENTENCES IN ACTIVE VOICE ARE NEGATIVE, I.E. IF THE VERB IS SAID TO BE IN ACTIVE VOICE, THE VERB IN THE PASSIVE VOICE WILL BE NEGATIVE.
4. THE WORD 'BY' IS USED TO SHOW WHO THE SUBJECT IS IN THE PASSIVE VOICE.
5. IF THE VERB IN ACTIVE VOICE IS FOLLOWED BY A PREPOSITION, THE SAME PREPOSITION WILL BE IN THE PASSIVE VOICE.
6. IF THE VERB HAS TWO SUBJECTS IN THE ACTIVE VOICE, THE VERB IN THE PASSIVE VOICE WILL BE FOLLOWED BY BOTH THE SUBJECTS.

**CONVERSION OF DIRECT SPEECH TO AN INDIRECT SPEECH**

**DIRECT SPEECH** - The words which reproduce the exact words of a speaker are called direct speech.

**INDIRECT SPEECH** - The words which reproduce the meaning of what a speaker has said are called indirect speech.

**REPORTING VERBS** - The verbs which introduce the reported speech are called reporting verbs.

**SOME FUNDAMENTAL RULES FOR DIRECT SPEECH**

1. NO REPORTING VERB IS USED.
2. NO CHANGE IS MADE IN TENSE.
3. NO CHANGE IS MADE IN NUMBER.
4. NO CHANGE IS MADE IN PERSON.
5. NO CHANGE IS MADE IN GENDER.
6. NO CHANGE IS MADE IN PLACE.
7. NO CHANGE IS MADE IN TIME.
8. NO CHANGE IS MADE IN DEGREE.
9. NO CHANGE IS MADE IN STYLE.
10. NO CHANGE IS MADE IN VOICE.
11. NO CHANGE IS MADE IN TONE.
12. NO CHANGE IS MADE IN MANNER.

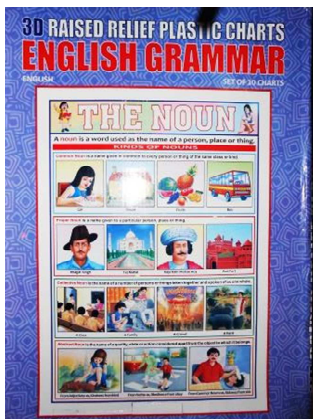
